Role Title: Urban Wild support role

Hours/Pattern of Work:

3 hours per week for set weeks of delivery on Thursdays 3:30-6:30 pm First block of 6 weeks starting early June 2025, next cohort dates TBC

Salary / payment

£50 / session paid on receipt of invoice (It is the post-holder's responsibility to declare this income if it takes you over your <u>trading</u> allowance)

Location/Primary Place of Work:

Primary place of work is the St Nicks Environment Centre and Local Nature Reserve (LNR).

Main Purpose of the Job:

This freelance role will support delivery of our new Urban Wild youth engagement sessions. These new sessions will take place on Thursdays 4:30-6pm for young people aged between 11-16 with blocks of 6 weeks delivery set over the year. The sessions will work with young people offering them a chance to engage with the outdoors and nature with a series of workshops with different themes. The session will be delivered by an experienced facilitator and this role will support them during the session. You will be expected to:

- Support session setup and some planning
- Support the lead facilitator in delivery of the session
- Engage with young people within a nature-based environment
- Support with session close down

- Experience of behaviour management when working with young people
- Experience of managing conflict in a youth setting
- Experience of delivering or supporting youth or community sessions
